



## Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS)

NewPage printing papers are defined as an "Article" and are exempt from the requirements of the Hazard Communication Standard as set forth in 29 CFR 1910.1200 and therefore Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) are not required.

Material Safety Data Sheets are a sub requirement of the Occupational Safety & Health (OSHA). This Hazard Communication Standard does not apply to various categories including anything defined by OSHA as an "Article". OSHA has defined an "Article" as a manufactured item:

1. Which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture;
2. Which has end use functions dependent in whole or in part upon its shape or design during end use; and
3. Which does not release, or otherwise result in exposure to, a hazardous chemical, under normal conditions of use.

This confirmation is valid for all NewPage printing papers as delivered and becomes invalid upon further processing other than dimensional changes.
