Eric,

This letter is in response to your inquiry concerning compliance with the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act (CPSIA) in relation to the products supplied to you by Universal Graphic Solutions, Inc. To the best of our knowledge and based on the information given to us by our suppliers, none of the inks, coatings, or varnishes that we supply to Paw Paw Press contain lead (16 CFR 1303), heavy metals (ASTM F963-07) or phthalates (California AB 1108) in amounts greater than mandated by the CPSIA. As you may know, trace contamination is possible in a manufacturing environment.

Our products also contain less than 100 parts per million (total quantity) of lead, cadmium, mercury, and hexavalent chromium, and are therefore in compliance with the CONEG regulations. The following is an individual list of metals and levels that have been detected by using the test method of PMCC. The amounts shown are the maximum amount detected in our entire stock of inks, coatings, and varnishes.

Antimony	< 30 ppm
Arsenic	< 10 ppm
Barium	< 10 ppm
Cadmium	< 12 ppm
Chromium	< 10 ppm
Lead	< 10 ppm
Mercury	< 10 ppm
Selenium	< 10 ppm
Sliver	< 10 ppm
